### A Kenyan Diary

In early September, our very own Africa Regional Avionics Manager, Dave, took a trip to the MAF programme in Kenya. Here's what he got up to!

**Day One:** Arrived in Kenya after a delay at Entebbe airport. It was too late to do much, but had chance to catch up with some of the team from Kenya and South Sudan over dinner.

**Day Two:** Things start early in Kenya. Traffic is a real problem here so we leave the house at 06:15 to make the eight-kilometre drive. My day started with catching up with the team and learning names of people I'd not had the chance to meet before. Then came week planning and the first session of training. In the evening a team from MAF Italy joined us in praying for the work we do as they visit a few programmes in the area.

**Day Three:** Today I had to chance to deliver training to the maintenance team. They recently received a new Cessna Caravan with a fully integrated avionics system. For engineers who normally only deal with the airframe and engines they now have to understand much more about electronics to be able to maintain the aircraft. It was great to be able to pass on my experience of the system as they begin to maintain this aircraft.

**Day Four:** It's amazing starting the day with the team in devotions. It's a large team in Kenya and being sat there surrounded by people from all walks of life, all here for the same purpose is incredibly humbling. Today was more training as I worked with the avionics team and the pilots on installing and operating a new wireless interface for our navigation systems.

**Day Five:** My last day here and the last day of training on the processes of our new dealerships. I also got the chance to help out with 5Y-ISA, the new Cessna Caravan bound for operations in South Sudan, advising the team and helping to setup the G1000 integrated avionics system that we'd trained on. Then it was time to grab an Uber and fly home to Uganda. An awesome week spent getting to know another amazing programme.

Dance camps provide an opportunity to bring these young people out of their situations at home, to teach them to do what they love, and to introduce them to a loving Jesus.

One of Hallel's weekly activities is a fellowship group, with a time of worship, prayer and Bible teaching. In July, Becky was invited to speak at the group about what it means to really live life to the full. She is looking forward to going back to speak again at the group soon.
